** Educational field trips and social events are scheduled on an occasional basis and may take place during and/or before or after scheduled class periods. All educational field trips and social events involve teacher contact.

*** The mid-term Progress Test is administered at the midpoint of the academic quarter and takes approximately 90 minutes to complete. Final course examinations (the end-of-term Achievement Test and full-length simulated TOEIC) are administered on two separate days during the last week of each academic quarter and take approximately 5.5 hours in total to complete. The final course grade is determined solely by final examination (the end-of-term Achievement Test), which directly measures the degree to which students have attained the course's written learning outcomes (see course outline for additional information on course grading policies).

**** Orientation and initial placement testing are conducted on or before the first day of class for all new students. New student orientation and initial placement testing take up to three hours. Ongoing orientation, advising and support are provided to all students by the school director and other qualified staff. Orientation, placement testing and ongoing advising typically take place outside of normal class hours.

Notes about typical and maximum lengths of program: The typical program length will vary for each student based on his or her starting level. A student who enters the program at the lowest level (Level 1), makes normal progress while advancing through the program and completes the highest level (Level 6) without repeating any levels will remain in the program for a total of 18 months. If that student elects to take the TOEFL or IELTS module, or the Pronunciation module, each of which requires an additional 3 months of study, then the student will exit the program in 21 months. If that student elects to take both the TOEFL or IELTS module, and the Pronunciation module, then the student will exit the program in 24 months. Because students may only repeat a level once (either due to failing the level or through an approved voluntary repetition), the maximum possible theoretical length of the program for a student who starts at level 1 would be 48 months. However, this scenario is uncommon.
